Dear Mr. Caton:

Guam Telephone Authority, by its attorneys, hereby submits the name of Robert F. Kelley to be a member of the North American Numbering Council.<sup>1</sup> Mr. Kelley is Advisor to the Governor of Guam, Carl T. Gutierrez. Among Mr. Kelley's responsibilities are oversight of telecommunications on Guam and advising the Board of Guam Telephone Authority on numbering and other issues.

Mr Kelley was involved in the recent successful effort to have Guam included within the North American Numbering Plan. Indeed, he should be credited with being the driving force behind that effort, working tirelessly over many months with representatives from Bellcore, the Commission, the Departments of

<sup>1</sup> GTA recognizes that nominations to the North American Numbering Council are officially closed and that the Council has begun its work. However, GTA has learned that the Commission has received a nomination from another representative from Guam. Consistent with the Federal Advisory Committee Act and the Commission's desire for a balanced presentation of views, GTA suggests that, if the Commission appoints John M. Borlas to the Council, then Mr. Kelley should also be appointed to the Council. If the Commission determines that Mr. Borlas should serve at a Working Group level, then Mr. Kelley's nomination should be considered at that level.
