This is in response to the Public Notice released by the Commission on October 4, 1996, DA 96-1664 (CC Docket 92-237). I am pleased to nominate Mr. Dennis J. Byrne to the Local Number Portability Administration Working Group of the North American Numbering Council. If the Steering Group members believe that it would be beneficial for Denny to participate in the leadership of this Working Group, he is available to do so. However, USTA will defer to other qualified nominees to this group who state a desire to participate in its leadership.

Denny is currently Executive Director of Operations and Engineering at USTA and has been employed in the telephone industry for 36 years in a variety of technical positions. Previous to joining USTA 10 years ago, he was engaged in technical planning activities for United Telecommunications, AT&T, and Mountain Bell Telephone.

Denny has been Staff Director for USTA's Numbering Planning Subcommittee for 10 years, and has served as Co-Chairman of the Industry Numbering Committee for the past two years. He was an active participant in the Future Numbering Forum during its existence, and has been active in the activities of the T1P1 Subcommittee addressing numbering for PCS. He has also participated in the activities of Study Group A addressing international numbering issues of concern to USTA members. He has participated as USTA's representative in development of Bellcore's specifications for local number portability. He is listed as my support on the North American Numbering Council and has full authority to speak for USTA in my absence. In these capacities, Denny has participated
