

This is a further response to the Public Notice released by the Commission on October 4, 1996, DA 96-1664 (CC Docket 92-237). While I recognize that this response is being filed two days late, this response could not have been submitted earlier because of the need to confer with USTA staff who were unavailable. I believe the Council would benefit from the option to consider this additional nomination, and would welcome USTA's offer of legal support for the Council's efforts.

I am pleased to nominate Ms. Mary McDermott as a USTA representative to the Legal Expertise Working Group of the North American Numbering Council, and Mr. Charles D. Cosson as her alternate representative to this group.

Ms. McDermott is currently Vice President, Legal and Regulatory Affairs at USTA. She has over a decade of experience in the telecommunications industry, and has final responsibility for USTA's LEC industry consensus efforts regarding numbering issues.
