Broadcasters, White House Agree On 'Educational' Programming

ought and won since February, and it reinforces his efforts to appeal to voters as a "family-friendly" candidate in the fall elections.

In February, the president signed legislation that requires TV set makers to include a "v-chip," circuitry that can be programmed by viewers to screen out offensive material. At a White House conference on TV violence a few weeks later, top Hollywood producers and executives pledged to create a "voluntary" rating system that will assign letters or symbols to rank virtually all TV programs for sexual situations, crude language or violence.

Yesterday's announcement came a day before Clinton's presumptive opponent in the November election, Robert J. Dole, was scheduled to visit Hollywood and attack its alleged excesses.

At a three-hour gathering at the White House of 50 producers, TV executives and such G-rated performers as Bill Cosby, Bill Nye and Fred Rogers of "Mr. Rogers' Neighborhood", Clinton praised the agreement. It "says to America's parents, you are not alone. We are all committed to working with

you to see that educational programming for your children makes the grade," the president said.

Broadcasters had long opposed a government edict on educational TV, saying such programming often draws small audiences and that a requirement to air it amounts to a violation of their First Amendment rights.

But the industry's opposition gradually eroded during the debate, in part because of pressure applied by Clinton, FCC Chairman Reed E. Hundt and Rep. Edward Markey (D-Mass.), the author of a 1990 children's TV law that encouraged but did not require more educational programming.

One possible obstacle remaining to the agreement: FCC commissioner James H. Quello, whose swing vote blocked an earlier version of the plan. He said yesterday that he would "reserve judgment until I review the final draft" of the plan.

The compromise plan was proposed last week by Ralph Gabbard, the chairman of CBS's affiliated station group. Stations that air less than three hours per week of regularly scheduled children's shows could offer an equivalent amount by running specials and public-

A LOOK AT THE NEW EDUCATIONAL TELEVISION REQUIREMENTS



■ **Definition:** Educational programming is designed for children 16 and under and serves their intellectual, social or emotional needs.

■ **Requirements:** Each week, three hours of 30-minute shows must air between 7 a.m. and 10 p.m. Alternatively, stations falling short of the three-hour standard could air public service announcements, specials and other shows 15 minutes in length.

■ **Impact:** Commercial and public broadcasters must comply but not cable systems, which are not federally licensed.

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service announcements or by financing educational programs that air on other stations.

Broadcasters that fall below the three-hour standard or its equivalent are unlikely to lose their licenses, White House officials acknowledged, but would have to face a lengthy and potentially expensive showing before the FCC to justify their program lineup.

"We think today will be the stimulus for a real golden age in educational programming," said Greg Simon, the White House official who brokered the plan.

Officials yesterday were speculating

as to what the FCC might rule to be educational. Simon suggested a station airing the teen situation comedy "Saved by the Bell" or Cosby's beloved family series from the 1980s, for example, might count these programs educational. However, neither show seems "specifically designed" to meet young viewers' educational needs.

Although saying they supported the general idea of yesterday's plan, several TV executives expressed unease over the definition's vagueness. "It's one of the bigger concerns for me," said Geraldine Laybourne, who heads ABC network's children's programming.

Broadcasters Pledge 3 Hours Of 'Educational' TV a Week

President Clinton announced an agreement with the television industry yesterday that would require stations to air three hours per week of "educational" TV shows for children. The accord comes amid a new round of presidential campaign rhetoric about cultural values.


Brokered by White House officials over the weekend, the deal won praise from both broadcasters and children's TV advocates, who said it was likely to end a long government stalemate over educational TV.

Still, the pact left unanswered questions about what would qualify programs as educational. The plan says the programs should be "specifically designed to meet the educational and informational needs" of young viewers,

but leaves it to the Federal Communications Commission to decide which programs meet that standard.

Proponents say that if the plan is formally adopted by the FCC it will force many stations to air more material such as "Bill Nye the Science Guy," "Where in the World is Carmen Sandiego" and "Beakman's World." However, other stations, already airing three hours or more of this type of fare, would not be much affected.

The proposal marks the third major cultural initiative that Clinton has
