This is to advise you that the Florida Public Service Commission on September 18, 1996 and the United States Telephone Association on September 20, 1996, filed a Section 402(a) Petition for Review of: Implementation of the Local Competition Provisions in the Telecommunications Act of 1996 and Interconnection Between Local Exchange Carriers and Commercial Mobile Radio Service Providers, FCC 96-325, CC Docket No. 96-98 and CC Docket No. 95-185, 61 Fed. Reg. 45476 (August 29, 1996).

Petitioners challenge the Commission's First Report and Order adopting rules to implement the 1996 Telecom Act's local competition provisions (Sections 251 and 252).

The Courts have docketed these cases as Nos. 96-3299 (11th Cir.) and 96-1352 (D.C. Cir.); and the attorney assigned to handle the litigation of these cases is Laurence N. Bourne.
