



Dear Mr. Chairman:

The purpose of this letter is to request a status report on the Commission's disposition of the Petition for Reconsideration filed by Cellular Service, Inc. and ComTech, Inc., on May 19, 1994, requesting reconsideration of the Second Report and Order, 9 FCC Rcd 1411 (1994), in the above-referenced docket.

As you know, Cellular Service, Inc. and ComTech, Inc. filed a petition for mandamus with the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit to obtain a court order requiring Commission disposition of the Petition for Reconsideration. In an order dated August 28, 1996, the court denied the petition for mandamus without prejudice to the right of Cellular Service, Inc. and ComTech, Inc. to refile the petition if the FCC had not acted on the Petition for Reconsideration by October 12, 1996. That date has come and gone without any Commission action. We are hopeful that the Commission will nonetheless act quickly in order to avoid the necessity of further proceedings before the court of appeals. However, if no action is taken by the Commission by Friday, November 1, 1996, Cellular Service, Inc. and ComTech, Inc. will feel compelled to refile their petition.
