
This letter concerns your pending request for authority to remain silent. Temporary authority is hereby granted for the above-referenced station to remain silent through January 9, 1993.

On December 11, 1991, the Commission adopted a Report and Order (copy attached) which amended Part 1 of the Commission's Rules, to implement Section 5301 of the Anti Drug Abuse Act of 1988. Pursuant to the Report and Order, any requests for extension of this authority must be accompanied by a certification that neither the applicant nor any party to the request is subject to a denial of Federal benefits under Section 5301. Please use the attached certification page to comply with this requirement.

Any further requests for extension of this authority must be accompanied by a detailed summary of steps taken to return the station to on-air operations. It will be necessary to maintain prescribed tower lighting in accordance with the stations license authorization. If an extension is not required, you are requested to notify the Commission, in writing, of the exact date the station resumes on-air operations.

In the event that any AM station remains silent for a period over 6 months, it will be necessary to file with the Commission, prior to returning the station to on-air operations, an FCC Form 302 for direct measurement of power which should include a partial proof of performance for stations with directional antennas.

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



We, the citizens in the listening area of KZOT-AM (1460) radio in Marianna, AR and KCLT-FM 104.5, West Helena, AR) object to the issuance of a license to operate KZOT-AM (1460) radio station to L.T. Simes II and Raymond Simes, because of the following reasons:

L.T. Simes and Raymond Simes are Co-owners and operators of KCLT-FM (104.5) in West Helena, AR which is also in our listening area.

There are complaints filed with the FCC against this station now regarding the indecent and obscene lyrics being aired, among other complaints. A group of ministers in our community have met with the owners, L.T. Simes and Raymond Simes on different occasions. Enclosed is a newspaper clipping of the first meeting. However, the owners showed no respect for the ministers nor the other concerned citizens in the listening area who brought this issue to the ministers in our communities.

Also Mr. L.T. Simes has used KCLT-FM 104.5 station as a political platform since its existence, to help pursue his political goals, which has been unsuccessful due to the dissatisfaction of the citizens in the communities for which Mr. L.T. Simes (who is primary owner of KCLT-FM radio) is serving as an attorney at law and with the radio station. In Mr. L.T. Simes most recent political race, his opponent beat him by receiving in excess of 80% of the votes. Again that tells you how we the citizens feel about the service and behavior of the owners of KCLT-FM. His opponent had to threaten the owners and manager of KCLT-FM in order to get his ads ran over the air.

For these reasons and others, we the undersigned citizens object to the issuance of a license to operate KZOT-AM (1460) radio station in Marianna, AR.

In order to illustrate the gravity of the situation, some examples of lyrics, gleaned by random spot checks, are listed below. Many of these are very offensive. It should be noted that, in the samples examined, explicit and implicit sexual overtones are pervasive. While some lyrics have been isolated for examination, an overwhelming majority of the material played on the station between the hours of 6:00 and 10:00 am, and 3:00 and 8:00 pm (when the broadcast is live from Helena-West Helena) is filled with sexual lyrics or innuendoes, including sounds of heavy breathing, moaning, etc. It should also be noted that random checks have been made of other radio stations in the area, both KFFA and KCRI. In those checks explicit sexual language has not been discovered.

Some of the "milder" sexual lyrics are found in songs such as: "I Want to Sex You Up," by a group called Color Me Badd:

*I want to make you feel all right,
All I want to do is rub you down all night,
I want to sex you up.*

More graphic is the song by the female rap group, TLC, called "Ain't Too Proud to Beg:"

*If I need it in the morning,
or the middle of the night,
I ain't too proud to beg.*

Then a reference is made to what is needed, obviously referring to a penis:

*Two inches or a yard, rock hard or if it is saggin'
I ain't too proud to beg.*

The above line requires very little in the way of imagination, but the lyrics become more graphic in other songs. An example is the following from a rap song by a performer called Big Daddy Kane:

*I wanna do something freaky to you,
Take you to a level that you've never been to.
'Cause no one knows where the nose goes
When the door's closed, so take off your pantyhose
I wanna see you moan and groan
As I nibble on your bodily parts,
as I proceed to jump your bones.
And put your feet up here, my dear
So I can lick upon your toes
Until your Revlon disappears.
The passion between us will be so incredible,
As I prove that a woman is edible.*

Or, from a rap singer whose name we did not catch, the song, "Spend a Little Time Wit' You:"

*Lick you like a lollipop,
from the bottom to the top;
Eat you like a tootsie roll,
Make you loose control.
All I want to do is get with you...*

In addition to the sexually explicit lyrics, which we would consider inappropriate for broadcast, especially since the audience is primarily teens and young teens, there are lyrics that are very sexist, and quite dangerous. In a song (which, strangely enough, begins with the prayer-- "Now I lay me down to sleep") by Aaron Hall called "Don't Be

Aired on radio

Ministers express concern over musical lyrics

Local citizens have voiced their concern about indecent lyrics in certain songs. These concerns were expressed about the lyrics which allegedly have been aired on local radio station KCLT, which broadcasts at 104.9 FM, in a meeting of the Phillips County Ministerial Fellowship on March 17.

A sample of the lyrics were played for the group at the meeting. "It was shocking," according to a press release issued by the Ministerial Fellowship, a group of black and white ministers in the Twin Cities. "It was then suggested that the matter be investigated further. It was decided that lyrics would be transcribed, distributed to members of the alliance, and action would be taken at that time.

"We are aware of the first amend-

ment, and are very wary of censorship — for, as ministers of the Gospel we realize that when voices are silenced by government intervention there is always danger. However, there are community standards that must be maintained, and there is a code of decency that should be followed. While people should be allowed to voice opinions, raise issues, and promote a variety of artistic and musical forms; there are limits.

"Radio stations are responsible to the community, and the FCC is very considerate of acceptable community standards when determining what is or is not appropriate," the press release stated.

According to the Ministerial Fellowship some examples of lyrics were gleaned by random spot checks to "illustrate the gravity of the situation."

"Many of these are very offensive," the press release stated.

In addition to the "sexually explicit" lyrics, which the fellowship considers inappropriate for broadcast. "especially since the audience is primarily teens and young teens," said the Ministerial Fellowship, "There are lyrics that are very sexist

and quite dangerous.

"In a song (which, strangely enough, begins with the prayer — 'Now I lay me down to sleep') called 'Don't Be Afraid,' the scenario sounds very much like date rape."

"The lyrics are frightening, obscene, and sexist," the ministers say. "Apparently the singer is lauding his ability to perform sex, and it seems that he is forcing himself on an unwilling partner."

The ministers said that these lyrics are only a representative sample of music being played on KCLT.

"Such lyrics morally desensitize our youth and exacerbate existing problems such as teen pregnancy, promiscuity and sexually transmitted diseases. The problem must be resolved, for our young people are at risk," they said.

KCLT owner, Raymond Simes, attended the fellowship's meeting Thursday to hear their concerns. No

action was taken by the group at the time.

Ted Witcher, president of the Ministerial Fellowship said "Hopefully because of the openness and discussion that took place, there will be positive action taken by the radio station. We just presented our case for decency's sake. Think what a great example it would be if KCLT were one of the radio stations who checked their musical broadcasting for indecent lyrics."

Simes said that it is his understanding that the lyric sample in question were gathered by Elija Mondy, owner of KJIW radio, a Christian radio station here in Helena and presented to the fellowship.

"I feel that this may just be an attempt to hurt our listenership by competitor," Simes said. "There was not one of the ministers at the meeting who had ever even listened to our station."




