Dear Mr. Caton:

On November 14, 1996, the American Mobile Telecommunications Association, Inc. (AMTA) made an oral *ex parte* presentation concerning the above-referenced proceedings to Jackie Chorney, Senior Legal Adviser to Chairman Reed Hundt, and to Suzanne Toller, Legal Adviser to Commissioner Rachelle Chong, in separate meetings. On November 15, 1996, AMTA made an oral *ex parte* presentation concerning the same proceedings to David Siddall, Legal Adviser to Commissioner Susan Ness.

Each meeting consisted of a discussion concerning elimination of the "40-mile rule" in the 220 MHz service and the progress of the FCC's work on a Report and Order outlining new rules for the 220 MHz service. Also discussed was revised language AMTA recently filed with the Commission concerning the appropriate definition of "covered SMR" systems in other matters listed above. AMTA has filed Petitions for Reconsideration in these dockets proposing amendment of the FCC's definition.
