This is to advise you that America's Carriers Telecommunication Association on December 13, 1996, and Sprint Corporation on January 7, 1997 filed a Section 402(a) Petition for Review of: In the Matter of Policy and Rules Concerning the Interstate, Interexchange Marketplace, CC Docket Nos. 96-61, FCC 96-424, released October 31, 1996.

Petitioner challenges the FCC rulemaking order prohibiting nondominant interexchange carriers from filing tariffs.

The Court has docketed these cases as No. 96-1477 and No. 97-1009. The attorney assigned to handle the litigation of this case is Laurence Bourne.
