
A telephone conference was held on March 4, 1997 to set a pleading cycle for a Motion For Limited Discovery And The Taking Of Additional Hearing Testimony, Or, In The Alternative, To Enlarge Issues ("Time Warner's Motion") that was filed on March 3, 1997. After full discussion, with no party objecting, the following pleading schedule was set:

- March 14, 1997 Opposition of Liberty and Comment of Bureau to Time Warner's Motion.<sup>1</sup>
- March 20, 1997 Reply of Time Warner (optional).

In addition, an adjustment was made sua sponte to permit the filing of Reply Proposed Findings and Conclusions on **March 10, 1997**.<sup>2</sup>
