In accordance with the agreements reached at the prehearing conference on March 19, 1997, IT IS ORDERED that the following procedural schedule IS HEREBY established:

- June 19, 1997 - End Discovery.
- July 3, 1997 - Exchange of applicant's direct case.<sup>1\*</sup>

<sup>1</sup> Applicants ARE DIRECTED to submit exhibits numbered consecutively from the last numbered exhibit from previous hearing. All exhibits will be assembled in a binder with each exhibit bearing a number with a tab on each document. An index containing a descriptive title of each exhibit shall be submitted. The exhibits will be serially numbered. A prefix will be used to indicate the party sponsoring the exhibits. Each exhibit shall be separately and consecutively paginated, including attachments. If stipulations are entered into, they are to be executed by counsel, prepared as joint exhibits, suitably bound, tabbed and paginated.


