This is to inform the Commission that representatives of the South Carolina Public Service Authority ("Santee Cooper") and the undersigned met with Michael Hamra and Zenji Nakazawa of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau on May 29, 1997, to discuss Santee Cooper's Petition for Reconsideration and/or Clarification filed in the above-captioned proceeding. In addition to issues discussed in the Petition, we indicated that Santee Cooper's Reply to Oppositions to the Petition (due to be filed on June 4, 1997) would state that third-party verification would not be a problem if the Commission allowed microwave incumbents to seek reimbursement for microwave relocation that occurred prior to the Second Report and Order in this proceeding.
