Under consideration are "Motion To Quash Subpoena" filed June 3, 1997 by Kenneth R. McVay (McVay), "Motion And Memorandum To Quash Subpoena" dated June 3, 1997 by Gene Belardi (Belardi), and Wireless Telecommunications Bureau's Opposition To The Motions Of Gene Belardi and Kenneth McVay To Quash Subpoenas filed June 5, 1997.

McVay and Belardi seek to quash subpoenas which required them to testify at the hearing which was scheduled to begin on June 10, 1997. By Order released June 6, 1997 (FCC 97-197), the Commission stayed this proceeding for a period of ten (10) months. The motions to quash, therefore, are moot.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED, That the "Motion To Quash Subpoena" filed June 3, 1997 by Kenneth R. McVay and the "Motion And Memorandum To Quash Subpoena" dated June 3, 1997 by Gene Belardi ARE DISMISSED.
