WEYS Television Corp., licensee of WEYS(TV), Key West, Florida, by counsel, hereby submits its response to the Commission's request for information regarding television LMAs. The following numbered responses will correspond to the numbered questions in the request for information released by the Commission on June 17, 1997.

- (5) a. Term of the LMA: Begins January 1, 1997 -- expires one year thereafter

b. Renewal provisions: "Any renewal of the term shall be on mutually agreeable terms and conditions. The parties agree to notify each other of their respective intentions with respect to the renewal of this Agreement not later than 90 days prior to the expiration hereof and, if appropriate, shall promptly enter into negotiations with respect to any such renewal."

(6) 100% of the brokered station's weekly broadcast hours are brokered to the brokering entity, with the licensee reserving three hours per week.


