
As your files will indicate the licensees of Stations KETK(TV), Jacksonville, Texas and KLSB(TV), Nachogdoches, Texas filed a response to the Commission's request for LMA information on July 8, 1997. For convenience, a copy of the stamped-in copy of this submission is attached hereto.

The reference in numbered paragraph 1 incorrectly states that the Brokered Station, KLSB, operates on Channel 56 and the Brokering Station, KETK, operates on Channel 19. The opposite is, in fact, correct. Station KETK operates on Channel 56 and Station KLSB operates on Channel 19.

Numbered paragraph 5 correctly states that the term of the Agreement is 10 years, but incorrectly refers to the execution date as the beginning of the term. The commencement date was March 14, 1997, and the term is thus March 14, 1997 - March 14, 2007. Also, numbered paragraph 5 refers to a right of first refusal. The provision referred to is actually notice given to the Brokering Station of commencement of negotiation with third parties rather than a right of first refusal and there is no right of first refusal.





KLSB-TV Public Interest Benefits

The time brokerage agreement currently enjoyed by KLSB-TV has given the station the financial ability to continue its service to Nacogdoches, Texas in much the same form as its previous operation as a satellite to, under common ownership with, KETK, Jacksonville. In addition to the program offerings, the TBA results in a continuation of staffing by 16 full time and 2 parttime employees of the broker, in addition to KLSB's General Manager and Chief Engineer, employees of the licensee.

KLSB offers Public Service announcements geared to the Nacogdoches community not aired by brokering station KETK and airs popular programs not aired by KETK including Cosby, Strange Universe, Coach, Court TV and a different feed of NBC News Sunrise.

Future benefits that may result from the TBA include a news broadcast covering the Nacogdoches community which would originate from the KLSB studios. Such a broadcast is currently under examination for its financial and technical feasibility.

Also planned is an increase in the operating power of KLSB, which will broadly expand coverage to the Nacogdoches community. An FAA Determination of No Hazard of the tower for this project was received June 12, 1997. Without the TBA, the anticipated improvements to the KLSB transmission facility would not be possible.
