AT&T MOTION FOR CONFIDENTIAL TREATMENT OF CALL DISTRIBUTION DATA RELEVANT TO THE COMMISSION'S PROPOSED SETTLEMENT RATE BENCHMARKS

IB Docket No. 96-261

AT&T Corp. ("AT&T") has filed a motion for the Commission to grant confidential treatment for documents that AT&T has filed under seal for inclusion in the record of the above-referenced proceeding.¹ The documents contain call distribution data on U.S.-originated calls within each of the countries for which the International Bureau calculated a tariffed components price. AT&T states that this data represents competitively-sensitive proprietary information that is exempt from disclosure under Sections 0.457 and 0.459 of the Commission's Rules. AT&T requests that it only be required to give access to parties of record in this proceeding pursuant to the terms of a Confidentiality Agreement that it has attached to its motion. AT&T would make these documents available for inspection pursuant to the terms of the Confidentiality Agreement at the premises of AT&T, 10th Floor, North Tower, 1120 20th Street, NW, Washington, DC, 20036, Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5 p.m. AT&T asserts that grant of its motion will serve the public interest by allowing full development of the record in the *Settlement Rate Benchmarks Proceeding* while protecting the proprietary commercial information of AT&T.
