On August 11, 1997, undersigned counsel to BizTel, Inc. held a telephone conversation with Richard Engelman, Chief of the Planning and Negotiations Division in the International Bureau. The topic of the conversation was a review of issues previously raised in the above-referenced proceeding that generally relate to the accommodation of terrestrial fixed and satellite service spectrum requirements in bands between 30 GHz and about 50 GHz.
