**PETITION FOR REDUCTION OF REGULATORY FEES**

Citadel Communications Co., Ltd. ("Citadel") was the licensee of television station KLKE, Albion, Nebraska (formerly KCAN-TV) when Fiscal Year 1994 regulatory fees were paid. KLKE operated in 1994 as a satellite of station KCAU-TV, Sioux City, Iowa, which is also licensed to Citadel.<sup>1</sup>

In a Memorandum Opinion and Order, the Commission determined that licensees of both full service and satellite television stations may file petitions for reduction of their Fiscal Year 1994 regulatory fees so that each set of parent and satellite stations will pay a regulatory fee based on the total number of households served and will be assessed a single regulatory fee comparable to the fee assessed stations serving markets with the same number of television

households. See Assessment and Collection of Regulatory Fees for the 1994 Fiscal Year, 62 F.R. 39450 (July 23, 1997) (the "Order").


