**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

Marc D. Sobel d/b/a Air Wave Communications ("Sobel"), by his attorney and pursuant to Section 1.205 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, 47 C.F.R. § 1.205, hereby respectfully requests an extension of time in which to submit proposed findings and conclusions and replies thereto in the captioned proceeding.

The current filing deadlines are 15 September 1997 for Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and 6 October 1997 for Reply Findings. Order (FCC 97M-13415; released 5 August 1997). Sobel respectfully requests that the date for Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law be extended to 25 September 1997 and that the date for Reply Findings be extended to 16 October 1997. The additional time is required, in part, because undersigned counsel for Sobel was recently incapacitated for more than a week due to illness. In addition, Sobel's recent business activities have reduced the amount of time he has been available to consult with counsel and assist in the preparation of the pleadings. This brief ten day extension will not prejudice any party and will not unreasonably delay the progress of this proceeding. Counsel for the Bureau and for Intervenor, James A. Kay, Jr., have authorized Sobel to represent that there will be no objection to the requested extension of time.
