This letter serves as notification that on September 22, 1997, Mark Golden, R. Michael Senkowski and Angela Watkins, representing The Personal Communications Industry Association, had a meeting with James Schlichting, Patrick Donovan, and William Bailey (Competitive Pricing Division, Common Carrier Bureau) and Jeanine Poltronieri and Peter Wolfe (Wireless Telecommunications Bureau). The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the application of the Commission's rate integration rules to Commercial Mobile Radio Service (CMRS) providers. Specifically, we discussed: (1) how the FCC intends to define an "interstate, interexchange" service; (2) how the FCC will treat the complex ownership structures of CMRS providers under the affiliate rule; and (3) what CMRS rates must be integrated.


