The parties have agreed to the following pleading cycle concerning the Audit Report¹ which Liberty produced on September 16, 1997, pursuant to a mandate of the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit:

- October 1, 1997 - Time Warner/Cablevision Motion.
- October 15, 1997 - Liberty Opposition and Bureau Comment.
- October 22, 1997 - Time Warner/Cablevision Reply.

Counsel for Liberty furnished copies of the Audit Report under cover of letter stating that Liberty's counsel "will take no further action to prevent public disclosure of the internal audit report." The copy of the Report furnished to the undersigned was stamped on each page as "Confidential Not For Public Inspection". Liberty should forthwith furnish copies to the parties and

to the Presiding Judge without the confidential designations. Liberty also should file such a non-confidential copy with the Secretary with a specific instruction that the Audit Report is to be placed on the public record.
