
ORDER

Issued: October 22, 1997 ; Released: October 24, 1997

The Presiding Judge is in receipt of replies to proposed findings filed by the parties in the above-named proceeding. Although James A. Kay, Jr. ("Kay") has filed a reply to the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau's ("WTB") proposed findings, he did not file any proposed findings. Marc Sobel ("Sobel") had selected to file proposed findings only on the issue of unauthorized transfer of control reserving the right to reply to WTB's proposed findings on the misrepresentation/lack of candor issue. The actions by Kay and Sobel in not filing proposed findings of the misrepresentation/lack of candor issue precluded the WTB from providing the judge with its comments on Sobel's and Kay's analysis of said issue. The Presiding Judge however deems it useful to have WTB's comments on Kay's and Sobel's replies to WTB's proposed findings on said issue.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that WTB has until October 31, 1997 to file its comments on Sobel's and Kay's replies to its proposed findings on the misrepresentation/lack of candor issue.
