
1. This Order grants the Request for Extension of Time of Chameleon Radio Corporation dated October 17, 1997.

2. Chameleon's Request seeks a 15 day extension of time to file an appeal of the Initial Decision, FCC 97D-11, released in this proceeding on September 18, 1997. Chameleon asserts that, due to a lack of funds, it has been representing itself pro se and that delays have resulted from the need of the applicant to familiarize itself with the requirements for carrying on its case. The Mass Media Bureau has indicated that it will not file an opposition to this request. Under these circumstances, it appears that good cause has been shown and that the Request may, therefore, be granted.

3. ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to the authority delegated under 47 C.F.R. § 0.251(c), that the Request for Extension of Time filed by Chameleon Broadcasting Corporation IS GRANTED and that the time for filing IS EXTENDED to and including November 4, 1997.

4. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 1.51(a)(2) an original and 14 copies of any appeal SHALL BE PREPARED in accordance with 47 C.F.R. §§ 1.276, 1.277 and FILED with the Commission's Secretary, a copy SHALL BE SERVED upon counsel for the Mass Media Bureau, and a courtesy copy SHALL BE SENT to the undersigned at Room 610, 1919 M St. N.W., Washington, D.C. 20554.
