
Dear Mr. Caton:

On Thursday, October 30, 1997, Kathy Pounds (MCI), Bryan Green (MCI), Marc Goldman, from the law firm of Jenner & Block representing MCI, Jerry Epstein, also from the law firm of Jenner & Block representing MCI, Susan Jin Davis (MCI), and the undersigned, met with Michael Pryor, Robert Tanner, and Jordan Goldstein from the Policy Division of the Common Carrier Bureau.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss Operations Support Systems (OSS) in the BST Region. All issues raised are filed in MCI's comments in the above-captioned proceeding. MCI also discussed (1) the hours that BST's customer service representatives are available to MCI representatives serving new local customer accounts, and (2) the 50 page limitation for new entrants on electronic access to customer service records.
