Dear Mr. Caton:

On November 6, 1997, I met with Ari Fitzgerald of Chairman Kennard's office and separately with Karen Gulick of Commissioner Tristani's office. On November 7, 1997, I met with Steve Kaminer of Commissioner Furchtgott-Roth's office. Mr. Glenn Manishin, Mr. Martin Stern (both counsel for WebCel) and Mr. David Mallof, President of WebCel also attended these three meetings. I discussed USTA's position that the LMDS auctions should be delayed by the Commission. Such a delay would allow the appellate court to act on USTA's expedited appeal, and would allow designated entities time to adjust their business plans to account for the elimination of installment payments. My comments were consistent with USTA's previous filings in this docket.
