On November 5, 1997 Harry Sugar and I, of AT&T, met with Carol Matthey, Jonathan Askin and Kyle Dixon, all of the Common Carrier Bureau's Policy and Program Planning Division. The purpose of this meeting was to discuss the status of local number portability ("LNP") implementation to date and, more specifically, progress in deploying the regional LNP databases and administration centers ("SMS/NPAC"). AT&T indicated that it expects the SMS/NPAC being deployed by Perot Systems to be operational by 12/15/97, in keeping with the current, revised schedule.
