On Monday, November 17, 1997, Mark Baker, Rick Bailey, and Jim Talbot of AT&T, and Marius Schwartz, on behalf of AT&T, met with Commissioner Michael K. Powell, Peter Tenhula and Kathleen Franco to discuss the settlements manipulation by foreign affiliate entrants. AT&T demonstrated that switched resellers can manipulate the settlements subsidy in favor of their affiliates. AT&T also discussed its concerns with the Telmex/Sprint 214 and the Sprint accounting rate modification.
