Ameritech<sup>1</sup> submits this supplement to its refund plan filed on July 28, 1997. In connection with its investigation into the amount of refund that it might owe its customers pursuant to the Commission's order in this proceeding,<sup>2</sup> Ameritech has discovered that, because of problems associated with making




