This is to advise you that AT&T Corp. on November 7, 1997, filed a Section 402(a) Petition for Review of: Policy and Rules Concerning the Interstate, Interexchange Marketplace: Implementation of Section 254(g) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, CC Docket No. 96-61, FCC 97-293 (released August 20, 1997).

AT&T challenges the Commission's decision to forbear from tariff filing requirements for nondominant interexchange carriers.
