On January 26, 1998, Dennis F. Strigl and Mark Tuller of Bell Atlantic Mobile, Riley Temple of Halprin, Temple, Goodman & Sugrue, and the undersigned met with Chairman William E. Kennard and Commissioner Gloria Tristani.

In those meetings we stated our concerns as set forth in our written comments about the July 15, 1997 order of the Pennsylvania PUC regarding the 215, 610 and 717 NPAs, the PUC's related order rationing NXX codes and the problems which these actions have caused wireless carriers.

Additionally, we discussed concerns, previously addressed in written comments, about the problems associated with the cost of certain regulatory obligations (CALEA, Number Portability, E911) and the impact on BAM's ability to serve customers.
