**SUMMARY OF WIRELESS ISSUES
OF INTEREST TO UTC**

A. Microwave

1. **Microwave Cost-Sharing** (WT Docket No. 95-157) -- UTC supports clarification of an incumbent's ability to self-relocate and fully participate in cost-sharing.
2. **Re-Write of Part 101** (WT Docket No. 94-148) -- UTC supports reconsideration of unnecessary restrictions on sharing of private microwave capacity with CMRS licensees and other common carriers.
3. **2 GHz Mobile Satellite Service** (WT Docket No. 95-18) -- UTC supports FCC's decision to provide for relocation/reimbursement of incumbent microwave systems.
4. **Multiple Address Systems** (WT Docket No. 97-81) -- Sufficient MAS spectrum should be allocated for telemetry use by utilities and other public safety/public service entities.

B. Land Mobile

1. **Private Land Mobile Refarming** (PR Docket No. 92-235) -- UTC supports special coordination protections for services, including utilities and pipelines, which were identified as "public safety radio services" in the Budget Act of 1997.
2. **800 MHz Reallocations** (PR Docket No. 93-144) -- The FCC should reconsider the reallocation of the General Category in light of the Budget Act of 1997.
3. **Public Safety Allocations** (WT Docket No. 96-86) -- UTC supports flexible allocations/service rules to promote interoperability between public safety and public service providers.
