As counsel for ABC, Inc., I left voicemail messages on January 22 for Roy Stewart, Chief of the Mass Media Bureau, and on January 23 for Paul Misener, Senior Legal Advisor to Commissioner Furchtgott-Roth, Rick Chessen, Senior Legal Advisor to Commissioner Tristani, Anita Wallgren, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Ness and Jane Mago, Senior Legal Advisor to Commissioner Powell.

My message focussed on issues raised in ABC's timely filed Petition for Reconsideration of the Sixth Report and Order and in subsequent comments to the ex parte submission submitted by MSTV, NAB and other broadcasters in the above-captioned proceeding. Specifically, my message urged that the Commission change KABC-TV's current DTV Channel 8 assignment because of the significant interference that KABC-TV would both receive from and cause to NTSC Channel 8 in San Diego.

I also had a phone conversation with Ms. Wallgren who returned my voicemail. The substance of the conversation was to reiterate the position I had outlined in my earlier message.
