On February 12, 1998, Frank Meeks, Delbert Duncan (via conference call) and the undersigned representing SBC met with Marion Gordon, Andre Rausch, Pat Forster, and Gayle Radley Teicher representing the Network Services Division of the Common Carrier Bureau to discuss issues in the above referenced docket. The discussion focused on call processing problems in the Houston Texas, Dallas Texas, and St. Louis Missouri MSA's encountered as a result of the deployment of the long term number portability network architecture.
