Dear Ms. Salas:

On February 18, 1998, Henry Burkhalter, Vice-chair of the Government Relations Committee of the Wireless Cable Association International, Inc. ("WCA") and the undersigned met with JoAnn Lucanik, Lynn Crakes and Barbara Esbin of the Cable Services Bureau regarding the issues raised by WCA in its pending petition for reconsideration of the Commission's *Report and Order and Second Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking* in the above-referenced proceeding.

Mr. Burkhalter emphasized the points made by WCA in its petition, focusing in particular upon the marketplace consequences of permitting cable operators to threaten to remove home run wiring upon the termination of service in a multiple dwelling unit. In addition, he alerted the staff to the recent efforts of the franchised cable industry in the State of Mississippi to secure passage of state mandatory access legislation that discriminates in favor of the locally-franchised cable operator.
