Dear Ms. Salas:

Yesterday, on behalf of NextWave Telecom Inc. ("NextWave" or "Company"), Mr. Michael Regan and undersigned counsel discussed issues in the above-referenced proceeding with Mr. Ari Fitzgerald, legal advisor to Chairman Kennard. The views Mr. Regan and I expressed reflect the positions and ideas previously presented to the Commission in the Company's written filings, which are part of the public record in the proceeding.

NextWave Telecom Inc.

In particular, we respectfully requested that the Commission, on reconsideration, take targeted but effective steps to put small business licensees back on the path of rapidly building out their networks and delivering competitive wireless services to American consumers. At a minimum, those steps should include: (1) flexibility; (2) full, uniform credit of down payments under each option; and (3) application of down payments to interest. Imposing down payment-based penalties on licensees will undermine the competitive network deployment goals of the Entrepreneur Block program, and would be at odds with the precedent the Commission established in *Carolina PCS Limited Partnership*, 12 FCC Rec 22938 (1997).
