Dear Ms. Salas:

On Tuesday, March 3, 1998, Mark J. Golden, Senior Vice President, Industry Affairs of the Personal Communications Industry Association ("PCIA"), and Sheldon Moss, Manager, Government Relations of PCIA met with representatives of the FCC's Wireless Telecommunications Bureau and the FCC Local State Government Advisory Committee. This meeting was at the request of Wireless Telecommunications Bureau staff to discuss pending matters before the Local State Government Advisory Committee (LSGAC). Participating in the meeting from the Commission were Roz Allen, Steve Weingarten, Jeanine Poltronieri, Jeff Steinberg, Steve Markendorff and Mark Rubin of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, and Bruce Romano of the Mass Media Bureau. Ken Felman and Julia Freeland of the Local State Government Advisory Committee participated by telephone.

In the course of the meeting, PCIA discussed its position, as reflected in the written record, regarding establishing clear, objective criteria for determining where a moratoria on wireless sites constitute a barrier to entry and would be pre-emptable under Sections 253 (a) and 332 (c) (3); described for the LSGAC the proposal by PCIA to implement a site search clearinghouse to facilitate and promote opportunities for wireless operators to collocate transmitter facilities; and described material developed by PCIA for its member companies to ensure timely and full compliance with FCC radio frequency exposure regulations at multi-user building based antenna sites.

Pursuant to §1.1206(b) of the Commission's rules, two copies of this letter are hereby filed with the Secretary's office and a copy of this filing is being sent today to the FCC staff members present during the meeting.
