SUPPLEMENT TO NOTICE OF
INTEREST AND CLARIFYING
COMMENTS

Beasley Radio Inc., ("Beasley"), licensee of Station WJST(FM) (formerly WROC), Fort Myers Villas, Florida, by its attorneys, hereby informs the Commission that it has closed on the acquisition of the station from WSUV, Inc., and reaffirms its view that the proposed modification of WJST's license from Channel 292A to 275C2 should expeditiously be approved. In support hereof, Beasley states as follows:

1. On December 4, 1997, Beasley submitted its Notice of Interest And Clarifying Comments, to alert the Commission that it proposed to buy WJST and step into the shoes of its predecessor-in-interest in this proceeding. Beasley further advised that counsel for Gulf Communications Partnership ("Gulf"), permittee of Station WAAD(FM), Tice, Florida, had authorized Beasley to state that Gulf no longer preferred Channel 229C2 (which was inconsistent with WSUV, Inc.'s proposal) and, in the interest of a prompt resolution of this proceeding "fully endorses the WSUV, Inc./Beasley proposal to allot Channel 292C2 to Station WJST and Channel 275C2 to Station WAAD." (at 2.)

2. Subsequently, Beasley's assignment application was granted and the sale has now been consummated. Accordingly, Beasley here reiterates its desire that the Commission promptly approve the foregoing proposal. We respectfully request that the Commission resolve

this proceeding, in order that 1.2+ million persons will receive new FM service as a result of the upgrades specified herein.
