

InfoRamp is a full service ISP with approximately 10,000 customers in Chicago, North central and Northeastern Illinois. About 90% of these customers are residential dial-up users. The company also provides web hosting for business clients and establishes dedicated point-to-point service arrangements. InfoRamp is part of a family of companies that includes Cellular Dynamics, the 19th largest cellular reseller (not agent) in the nation and Aces Group, a paging company. Altogether, the organization has over 30 employees, many of whom staff 7 retail stores and outlets in various rural areas. The company also works with a major retailer to operate a concession selling Internet, wireless and other communication services at 22 locations in Chicago and 35 locations in the surrounding suburban and rural areas. InfoRamp has been in business for 3 years.

12. Internet Connect Company

Internet Connect Company has been in business for approximately 3 years. Internet Connect serves the Florida area. The company currently has 30 employees, and provides dial-up Internet access, web hosting, and dedicated Internet access to approximately 7,000 customers, including both residential and business accounts.

13. MTP, LLC, dba JavaNet

MTP, LLC, dba JavaNet, was formed in August of 1995. JavaNet serves the entire states of Massachusetts and Connecticut, as well as a significant portion of Maine. JavaNet currently employs over 100 individuals, and serves in excess of 32,000 consumer and commercial subscribers with a wide range of IP related services. Recently JavaNet won a contract from the Massachusetts Department of Education to provide Internet access to many thousands of K-12 educators, at a subsidized rate of \$ 25.00 per year.

14. ProAxis Communications, Inc.

ProAxis Communications, Inc. has been in business for 3 years. ProAxis serves the Mid-Willamette valley of Oregon. ProAxis has 17 employees, and provides Internet access, network consulting, and Web hosting services to approximately 8,600 retail customers. These customers range from individual residences to large corporate clients, including hospitals and large medical groups.

15. Rockbridge Global Village

Rockbridge Global Village has been in business for approximately 3 years. The company serves western Virginia. The company has 9 employees, and provides Internet access, web hosting, collocation, voice over IP and networking solutions

to a total of approximately 1,500 retail customers, including individual dial-up accounts, business accounts using dedicated facilities, schools and educators.

16. **ShreveNet, Inc.**

ShreveNet, Inc. has been in business as an Internet provider for approximately 16 months. ShreveNet serves the Northwest Louisiana "Ark-La-Tex" area. The company currently has 10 employees, and provides Internet access and other services including web-hosting, virtual storefronts, etc., to approximately 2,000 retail customers, including both individual dial-up accounts and business accounts using dedicated facilities.

17. **Within Technology, Inc.**

Within Technology, Inc. has been in business for approximately 4 years. As an ISP, Within serves rural Greene County in Pennsylvania. Within also provides software design and consulting services on a nation-wide basis. Within currently has 10 employees, and provides Internet access and other services to approximately 650 retail customers, including both individual dial-up accounts and business accounts.

18. **ZoomNet**

ZoomNet has been in business for 2½ years, serving southern Ohio and parts of West Virginia and Kentucky. ZoomNet has over 7,000 subscribers, 95% of which are residential dial-up. ZoomNet also provides web hosting and design, dedicated services and consulting. ZoomNet employs 14 people at the present time. The company currently enjoys a growth rate of 8% per month, with less than 1% customer churn.
