On April 8, 1998, Ava Kleinman and Ralph Andreotta, of AT&T, and I spoke by telephone with Kyle Dixon in the office of Commissioner Powell. During the conversation, AT&T discussed the manner in which voice telecommunications are provided using the internet or using the internet protocol. The enclosed diagram was used during this discussion. AT&T also reviewed its position, as described in its comments filed in this proceeding, that to the extent that a provider offers both telecommunications and information services, the telecommunications portion must be assessed Universal Service Fund support obligations (and access charge assessments).
