**ORDER**

Issued: April 27, 1998 ; Released: April 29, 1998

This case was initiated by the Commission's adoption on April 2, 1998, of an Order To Show Cause And Notice Of Opportunity For Hearing FCC 98-60 ("Order To Show Cause").

The Order To Show Cause requires the filing of a written appearance in accordance with Section 1.91(c) of the Commission's Rules of Practice [47 C.F.R. §1.91(c)]. The assignment Order FCC 98M-46, released April 16, 1998, instructs all parties to be fully cognizant of Part I of the Commission's Rules and Regulations concerning Practice and Procedure.

There is no direction in the Order To Show Cause as to where filings are to be made. On April 24, 1998, legal size pleadings and papers were delivered in triplicate to the office of the undersigned Presiding Judge. On that same date, the pleadings and papers were redelivered by the Presiding Judge's Legal Technician to the Office of the Secretary where they should have been filed.

The applicable Rules of Practice provide:

All pleadings and papers relating to this hearing must be filed with the Office of the Secretary before 5:30 p.m. on or before the date they are due to be filed.<sup>1</sup> [47 C.F.R. §1.4(g).] The Office of the Secretary is located at 1919 M Street, N.W., Room 222, Washington, D.C. 20554.

All pleadings and papers filed in any Commission proceeding shall be on 8½ by 11 inch size paper. The text must be double spaced and typewritten. [47 C.F.R. §1.49(a).]

An original plus six copies of pleadings and related papers or documents are required to be filed with the Office of the Secretary.  
[47 C.F.R. §1.51(a)(1).]<sup>2</sup>

The Prehearing Conference set to be heard on May 19, 1998, at 9:00 a.m. shall be held in a courtroom to be assigned in the Offices of the Administrative Law Judges at 2000 L Street, N.W., Second Floor, Washington, D.C.
