REPLY OF AMERITECH

Ameritech¹ submits this reply to comments on the Common Carrier Bureau's Public Notice in the above-captioned matter.²

Numerous parties filed comments on the various high cost funding proposals. Many of those parties simply advocate proposals solely on the basis of the economic impact on them particularly, without regard to larger principles. Although comments of this nature contribute to the level of "noise" in the debate, they add very little substance.


In its careful attention to this matter, therefore, the Commission should, of course, keep its eye on the "big picture." As Ameritech noted in its comments, the Chairman's "8 Principles" for universal service provide a solid framework for analyzing the various proposals. Maintaining

support for rural carriers, recognizing the states' role in furthering universal service, ensuring competitive neutrality, and encouraging efficient investment, are all necessary aspects of a universal service funding plan that will not compromise other public policy interests. Again, the Commission's 25% plan, modified to permit rural carriers to continue to recover the interstate high cost support that they receive today (without offsetting reductions to their access charge levels), best fulfills those principles.
