I wish to voice my strong objection to the 35 cent pay phone 800# fee I must pay for every call I make with VoiceNet, my chosen long distance carrier. My cost per call is 15 cents per minute, charged in 30 second increments. Now, if I make a 25 second call, the total is 42.5 cents ...this now includes a 500% tax (fee?). I don't know of any other government endorsed/approved fee or tax that is this extreme. It not only a significant consumer burden, but the fee structure as developed is competitively disadvantageous to many telephone companies.
