On Monday, June 1, 1998, Robert McDonnell and Maureen Keenan, Bell Atlantic, Whit Jordan, BellSouth, Perin Hurewitz, Bellcore, and Frank McKennedy, United States Telephone Association (USTA), all representing USTA, met with Rich Lerner, Judy Nitsche and John Scott of the FCC's Competitive Pricing Division.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the impact on the 1998 Annual Tariff Filing Tariff Review Plan (TRP) of the Commission's proposal to require ILECs to recover their Universal Service Fund (USF) contributions through direct increases in Subscriber Line Charges (SLCs) in lieu of exogenous cost adjustments to the interstate access price cap indices. The discussion included clarification of implementation of the components of the Commission's plan, customer notification requirements, and treatment of each of the price cap baskets.
