I don't understand why you are blocking 1800 sky page numbers from pay telephones but it is having a big impact on my life and is putting my child's safety at risk. My son frequently pages me from pay phones to come and pick him up from after school activities. Since he is in high school some of the band activities run late into the evening and many times the ending time is variable, sometimes hours early and sometime hours later than expected. Many times a pay phone is the ONLY phone available to call me to come and pick him up. Not being able to page me will force him to wait sometime long periods for a ride in the dark after everyone else has gone home. Why are you putting my son's safety at risk?

It was reassuring to know he could get in touch with me from anywhere and anytime. You have effectively blocked that communication between my son and me. Please re-evaluate your decision and allow 1800 sky page numbers from pay phones.
