ORDER

Issued: June 4, 1998 ; Released: June 8, 1998

On June 2, 1998, the Compliance and Information Bureau ("Bureau") filed a Motion For Summary Decision. The Motion, if granted, would dispose of all issues set for adjudication and would provide a basis for the termination of this case without the necessity for a hearing.¹ Therefore, in order to consider the Bureau's Motion, it is necessary to cancel the hearing that was set for June 23, 1998.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the hearing that was set in the assignment order [FCC 98M-46] for June 23, 1998, IS CANCELLED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event that this case is not terminated by summary decision, a new hearing date shall be set by the Presiding Judge.
