Filing of a new Petition for Review in the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit.

This is to advise you that the Pennsylvania Telecasters Association on April 15, 1998, filed a 402(a) Petition for Review of the Memorandum Opinion and Order on Reconsideration of the Sixth Report and Order in Advanced Television Systems and Their Impact upon the Existing Television Broadcast Service, MM Docket No. 87-268, FCC 98-24 (released February 23, 1998) in the U.S. Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit.

Petitioner, an applicant for a construction permit for an analog television station on a channel currently allocated to State College, Pennsylvania, protests the decision in the order on review to establish DTV allocations for two neighboring communities and to decline to make a DTV allocation for State College.

The Court has docketed this case as No. 98-1212. The attorney assigned to handle the litigation of this case is Michele Walters.
