ORDER



Following the issue of Order, FCC 98M-57, on May 20, 1988, granting the Shurberg Fourth Motion For Further Extension of Procedural Dates, the Presiding Judge received Comments by the Mass Media Bureau and Richard Ramirez. Both comments were filed late (Cf. Sec. 1.294 (b) of the Commission's Rules) and were not previously taken into consideration.

Neither the Bureau nor Ramirez opposes a further extension of the procedural schedule in light of the possibility of a universal settlement. The Bureau, however, feels that beyond such extension no further extensions premised on a possible settlement would be warranted. The Bureau's point is well taken and the parties are so advised. Additionally, Shurberg will file a status report on the settlement negotiations by June 30, 1998.
