





Dear Ms. Magalie Roman Salas,

We are writing in support of the Petition for Rule Making filed by the LMCC seeking new spectrum allocations for private wireless users. We appreciate your quick action to place this petition on public notice.

Chrouch Communications, Inc. has been in business since 1952 selling and servicing two-way radios in 16 counties in Central Lower Michigan. We currently employ 17 full time staff to service over 3000 users of private wireless systems. Besides being a dealer our company relies primarily on UHF Two-Way radios to coordinate our own business activities. The use of these radios allows us to have instant contact with our employees which is very important to our public safety customers providing emergency services.

We have been dealing with a spectrum shortage for several years that just keeps getting worse. Many of our customers rely on radio systems in the 150MHz, 450 MHz, 800 MHz and 900 MHz to give them instant access to their employees. Because of the spectrum shortage there is often too much interference from on channel radio traffic for people to communicate information quickly and reliably. Many times this becomes a safety issue because vital information is either missed or misinterpreted. Poor communications is nearly always a financial burden because people can not be routed efficiently to the areas or jobs where they are most needed.

The spectrum shortage will most certainly effect our ability to meet the needs of our customers. What can we sell when all of the channels are too busy? Several years ago we decided we needed to build an 800 MHz trunked system to make available to our customer base because VHF and UHF systems were too busy. We only managed to license one site before licensing in that band was frozen. Now because we are too close to major metropolitan areas there are no frequencies available and almost no systems either.
