**REQUEST FOR NEW FM RADIO CHANNEL ALLOTMENT**  
(channel 245C3)

Now comes ALALATEX (Jean Hill, a general Partner) before the Federal Communications Commission to make request for a new FM radio channel at Cross Plains, Texas. ALALATEX makes statements and certifications as follows;

**STATEMENTS**

General

1. Cross Plains, Texas, is an incorporated community in Callahan County Texas, with a 1990 census population of 1,063 persons.
2. Presently Cross Plains has no local aural service.
3. Cross Plains meets the FCC requirements for local aural service since it is incorporated and has the local community indicia.
4. ALALATEX is a general partnership and will file an application for a construction permit if the FCC puts channel 245C3 at Cross Plains.
5. ALALATEX has attached the required certification for a petition for rule making filed without an attorney.

Technical

1. The community coordinates for Cross Plains were used as reference for the attached channel study.
2. Channel 244A at Eastland has been substituted using channel 238A.
3. Since there is no site restriction, no coverage map is included.
4. The attached channel spacing study demonstrates that channel 245C3 can be placed at Cross Plains

and not create any short spacing to other stations.

Conclusion

1. Channel 245C3 is clear for allotment at Cross Plains.
2. ALALATEX will file for the channel when the window is opened, and if granted the CP, will serve the residents of Cross Plains with its first aural service.


