Dear Ms. Salas:

On Monday, March 30, 1998, Jay Kitchen, President and Alan Ciamporcero, Chief of Staff of the Personal Communications Industry Association ("PCIA") met with Karen Gulick to discuss the above referenced dockets.

In the course of the meeting, PCIA encouraged the Commission to extend the compliance deadline for wireless number portability indefinitely (CC Docket No. 95-116), requested the Commission to lift mandatory PCS resale requirements (DA 97-115), reaffirmed the positions PCIA has taken in its filings on Calling Party Pays (WT Docket No. 97-207), asked the Commission to take the broadest possible view of federal jurisdiction of wireless services (WT Docket No. 96-6), and informed the Commission of the status of recent CALEA negotiations with the Department of Justice (CC Docket No. 97-213).
